<i>Introverso e come un mantra</i>	Introverted and like a mantra
<i>Dolce, delicato e leggero</i>	Sweet, delicate and light
<i>Cantabile</i>	Singable
<i>Etereo, senza accenti, evitando di enfatizzare anche l'accento metrico</i>	Ethereal, without accents, avoid emphasizing the metric accent
<i>Serioso</i>	Serious
<i>Serioso (quasi malinconico e piangente)</i>	Serious (almost with melancholy and tearful)
<i>La mano sinistra molto leggera e delicata</i>	The left hand should be very light and delicate
<i>Serioso, nobile, con risolutezza</i>	Serious, noble, with determination
<i>Solenne ma non pesante, como l'eco di campane di una chiesa lontana che suonano il "dies irae". Il suono diventa lentamente più Luminoso</i>	Solemn but not heavy. Like the echo of bells from a distant church that are ringing the melody from the Gregorian chant "Dies Irae". The sound slowly becomes brighter.
<i>Ampio, Luminoso e aperto, rinvigorito</i>	Large, bright and open, invigorated
<i>Cedendo alla melodia del pianoforte</i>	Yielding to the melody of the piano
<i>Riprendendo la melodia</i>	Taking back the melody
<i>Più maestoso</i>	More majestic
<i>Lasciando risuonare come campane lontane, ma ponderato, delicado e dolce</i>	Let it ring like distant bells, but thoughtful, delicate and sweet
